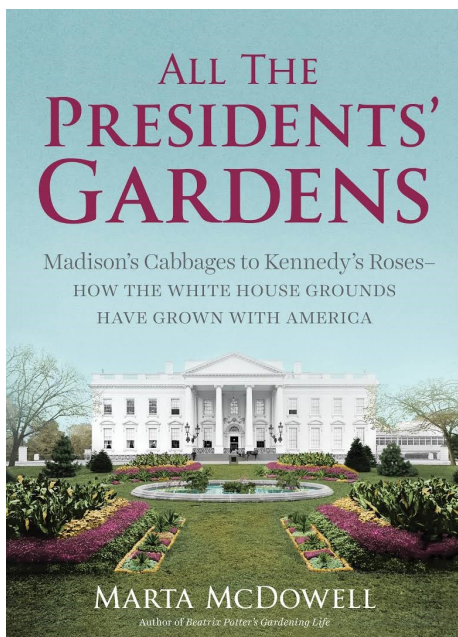
Best-Selling Author of
