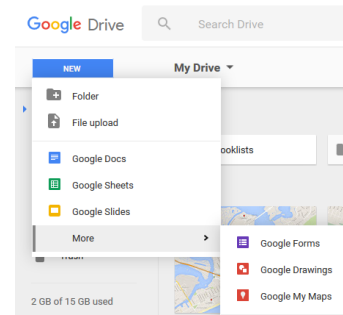
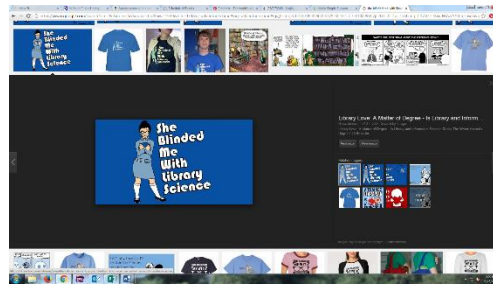


How Do I Make a Button/Magnet using Google Drawing?

1. Sign into your Google Drive and create a new Google Drawing.



2. Find an image you'd like to make a button out of—either a digital picture or an image from Google images.

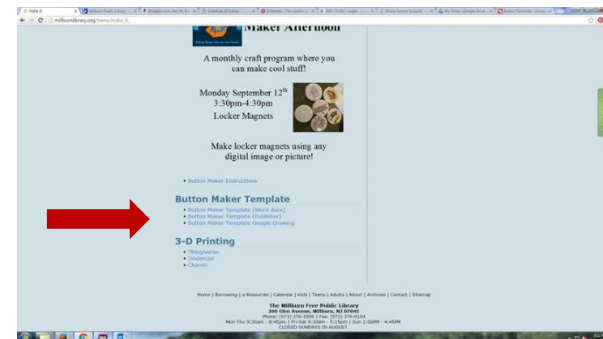


3. When you have found a picture, copy and paste the image in your Google Drawing.

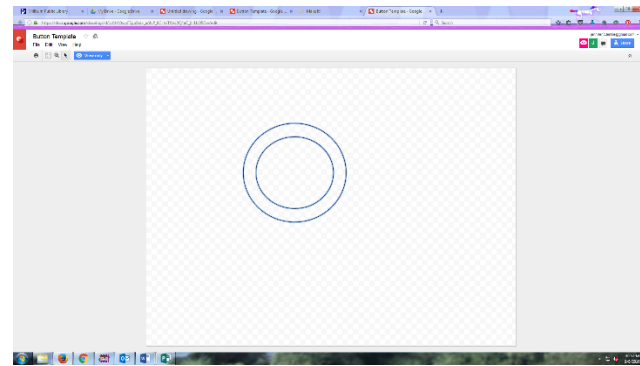


4. Go to the following website to access the Button Maker Template:

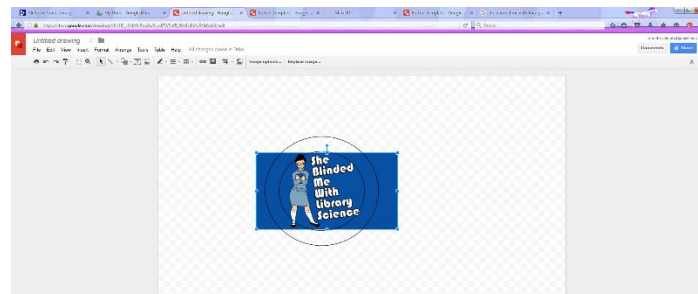

5. Open Button Template Word Google Drawing. Copy the circle.



6. Paste the circle so it is on top of the image. Move the circle over the image to make sure it will fit the button. The inside circle is what will show on the button. The outside circle will wrap around. Reduce the size of image until it fits inside of the smaller circle.



7. When you are sure it fits, move the circle off of the image and download it as a PDF and print the PDF. You are now ready to make a button or a magnet!
