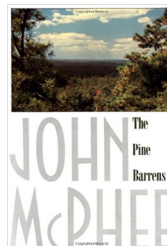

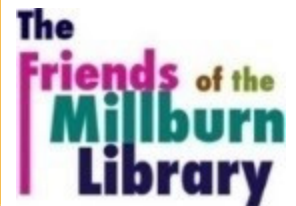


Exam Week Study Hall
