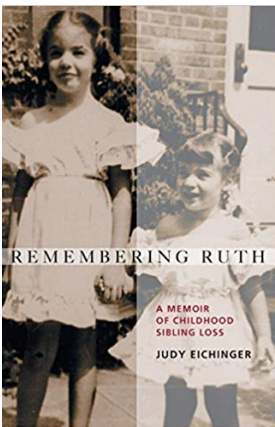
George Washington Remembers New Jersey Fri, Nov 2 | 2:00pm
